SECTION 1 — ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RISKS

SECTION 2 — RELEASE OF LIABILITY

SECTION 3 — PARTICIPANT RESPONSIBILITIES

I agree to follow safety instructions, remain aware of my surroundings, use equipment properly, stay out of the hitting area when others are swinging, and not participate while impaired or otherwise unsafe.

SECTION 4 — ASSUMPTION OF RISK

I acknowledge that injuries and accidents may occur and voluntarily assume all risks associated with participation.

SECTION 5 — PROPERTY DAMAGE

Participants may be financially responsible for damage caused by intentional acts, reckless behavior, or failure to follow safety instructions.

SECTION 6 — MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION

I authorize Birdies at Home personnel to contact emergency services if needed and understand I am responsible for related medical costs.
